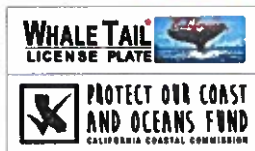

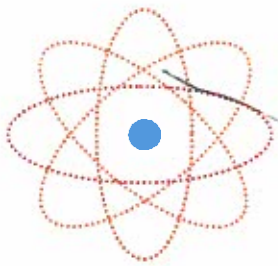

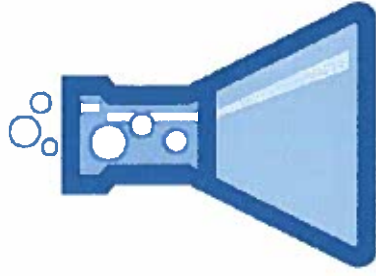

Who can participate?

Parents for Public Schools of San Francisco (PPS-SF) is looking for 5 to 8 African American parents, guardians or caregivers who live in 94124 and send their children to schools that are outside of the zipcode in which they live.

Why are we doing this research project?

This research project is done in collaboration with San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD) to better understand Bayview families' experiences and views about their neighborhood district schools.

What do participants need to do?

Participants will be interviewed by a PPS-SF staff in-person or over the phone and will take no more than 45 minutes per person. All personal information will be kept private and confidential.

Time and Location

Scheduling is flexible and PPS-SF staff are able to interview participants at a time and location that is convenient for them.

Compensation

All participants will receive \$20 for their participation in this research project.

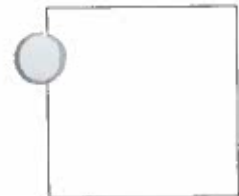
