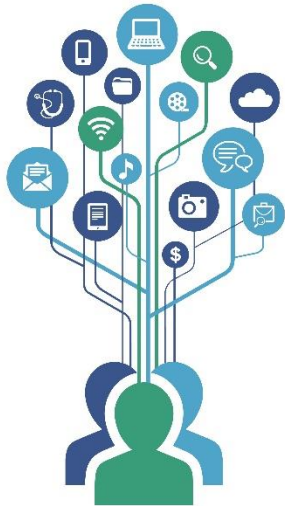

Learn about free resources, try virtual reality, see exciting technology in action, and check out the latest in assistive technology. Win a Chromebook or other prizes! All free.

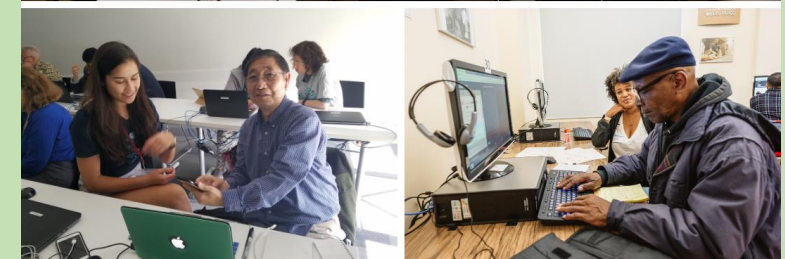
Preserving Memories. [Bayview Branch Library](#),
