 - ❖ **Presentation Notes:** They are a diverse team consisting of all parents acting as peer advocates, most of which have had involvement with the child service systems. They understand how CPS/HSA & mental health works and lived through the same experiences. Parents understand that someone has been through the same position as them & were able to get out of it. Immigrant families are unable to access as many services, so case management will help find resources. LEGACY works alongside CPS & protective social workers who utilize LEGACY as a bridge/mediator

to facilitate between the agency & family. Referrals can be from clinicians, social workers, school personnel, juvenile probation officers and self-referrals from caregivers and families.

❖ **Questions:**

Dr. Monique - Are parenting & housing resources available for just moms or for single/justice-involved dads? Services are client-based and provided to the agency's clients which are open to any caregiver or parent, does not need to be justice-involved.

Dr. Hollis - Alice Griffith Tenant Association meets the first Monday of each month. This is a good way to spread the love. They are from 6:00-7:00 pm.

Ms. Lydia - What is your capacity for each program? Currently case managers have 7-8 cases but they aren't full so they are welcoming as many referrals as possible. TAY population don't need to be in any child/family system but just need/want support. Looking for an intern to take on TAY cases but currently don't have any, so they can take referrals.

❖ **Presentation Notes:** Looking to bring back regular screenings & wellness as a passport program to see pre and post changes. 2 day Black Health Summit will be either in May or June. UMOJA is a \$10 million project that will be rolled out in the next 4-10 years, they will be asking for community input. One of the goals of the program is a curriculum about Black, joyful positive sexuality in all aspects. Vaccine Equity Program - offering access to vaccine, health & wellness offerings, grocery boxes & hot meals weekly through the end of March mid-days on Wednesdays and sometimes on Saturday.
