 - ❖ **Presentation Notes:** Public outreach launches today, BMAGIC is the first group to hear about it. SFMTA is looking for additional funding to keep the shuttle going past the 2+ pilot years. Working with APRI & YCD in partnership with OEWD's City Drive to recruit, train & hire local Bayview drivers who will receive union equivalent wages & benefits. Everyone hired will have the ability to enroll in City Drive & eligible for Class B driver's license to train as MUNI or commercial drivers. Transportation Resource Center will be a storefront on 3rd Street with CYC & BACR to run the center. Mobile Sales Van comes into the neighborhood where people can renew bus passes, pay for parking tickets, etc. Community Congress is in partnership with Bayview Hunters Point Community Advocates, still taking applications & members will be compensated. Shuttles are a dynamic service and do not have a specific route, operating in a similar format to Uber/Lyft pool/shared ride. Rides will be within Bayview & pay regular MUNI fare; all shuttles will have zero emissions. We are working with a broad coalition of community partners to deliver a shuttle serving Bayview's needs, organizing events throughout the rest of the year with Hunters Point Family, the SF African American Arts & Cultural District, MNC Evans Campus,

❖ **Questions:**

- *Maxine Gilkerson - Is the logo generic or is that what it will look like? The photo is an example & of a shuttle service in England. Shuttles are minivan sized and hold 6-8 passengers, to have flexibility for shuttles to go anywhere & have 6-8 vans out at once to maximize efficiency.*
- *Emily Wade-Thompson - How are you connecting with schools in terms of supporting students who have poor attendance due to transportation in the morning? Haven't yet but would love to get connected with different schools, will need to work out age requirements/limitations with the vendors. Very interested in connecting students to & from school/after school programs.*
- *Brittany Ford/Zi Terrence Smith - Have you got to the point where you have discussed how people will be able to access shuttles?/Hi Chris, have ya'll anticipated what traffic may look like for residences? For example, would there be shuttles coming every 15 minutes like Muni? Integrated with the MUNI fare system, likely through an app where you call for a ride & also have a trilingual call center. How long you'll have to wait depends on the service plan - how many vehicles out, how far they're going, etc. Expected maximum wait is 10-12 minutes. Rides are on demand and not pre-scheduled.*
- *Amy Deck - Presidio launched Presidio shuttle 10 years ago & would love to connect with their experience and lessons learned.*
- *Wendy Neikirk Rhodes - Will these shuttles be wheelchair accessible? Yes*

- ❖ **Presentation Notes:** Serves ages 4-18 at 3 different campus locations, in the Bayview they are focusing specifically on young singers ages 4-12. Partnering with Bayview YMCA for 2 years, offering programs once a week on Tuesday afternoons with 2 chorus ensembles; hoping the location will be an entry point to their music education journey. Launched new programming for older singers at the new Southeast Community Center, including 2 chorus ensembles. Ensembles are organized on age & skill level to help singers grow & progress together. At Carver, they started with 1 weekly class which was successful, so a 2nd class was added this year.
- ❖ **Questions:**
 - *Brittany Ford - Do you have a showcase at the end?* Yes, there is a showcase at the end of summer. *Where are you in Hayes Valley?* On Page Street between Gough & Franklin. *Do you work with beacons or CBOS?* Not currently, Brittany will reach out about that.
 - *Emily Wade-Thompson - When they have family fun days, do girls perform then so parents can be encouraged?* They performed during last school year, it's an ongoing conversation this year between the Girls Chorus & BGC. *Will you continue during the summer with them?* Carver is still TBD due to calendaring conflicts, they are meeting with the Carver beacon team next week to discuss. June 13th event at SECC is for all locations' year round programming but targeted to Bayview. *Are the locations run by the same person?* There are different people at Y vs. SECC, SECC instructor is also at Carver, there is consistency with the instructors.
