- ❖ 100% renewable energy is the vision of the PUC as climate change grows PG&E has placed roadblocks in the way because of this we are focused on owning our own power grid public power is a growing movement the SFPUC is SF's clean electricity provider through Hect hetchy power and clean power sf. sfpuc is providing more than 70% of the city's power pg&e still operates the grid which means that it is still the middleman that has caused obstructions of more than 100 local projects at cost to SF residents and communities by placing unreasonable demands on the city which has resulted in causing local taxpayers 28 million dollars with full public power sf can reach its 100% renewable goals. This would also ensure more affordable rates of public power are supported by the mayor Board of Supervisors and most of the city leaders
