❖ Home Match Matches seniors and adults with homes - this program is part of Front Porch which is a non-profit that offers affordable housing and market-rate retirement communities. We are a home-sharing program founded by the Mayor's office. We work with homeowners or master tenants who have an extra room that can be rented out. Anyone over 18 can apply for the program. Home Match offers affordable housing options, financial stability, the opportunity for aging in place, and social connections. Home Match only makes the introduction; they don't make the choice or determine the pricing of rooms. They try to make the best match between those offering rooms and those searching for a place to stay. Some home providers may request support with household tasks which can earn the home seeker reduced rent. Both Seekers and home providers must complete the application either online or physically. Home Match may be

able to assist the home provider with upgrades to ensure the space is up to California code. We take photos of the room without exposing the home provider locations. Home Match will also manage all applicants of home-seekers through the vetting process. Even mediation in case problems arise in the household.

- (Q)- Are there background checks on homeowners - (A) Yes both seekers and homeowners are run through the background checks -
